



The Eastern Cape Chapter Koi Competition 2020

With our 2020 Eastern Cape Koi Show been cancelled the Chapter is organising a “virtual” show in its place.

This is in essence a show where members can take a digital photograph and a short video clip (20 to 30 Seconds) of their koi and then measure the koi. All the details, need to be captured on a spreadsheet, i.e. the koi size in cm’s, variety of the koi and referencing of the Photos and Video clips. A standardised Spreadsheet will be supplied to the entrant.

These photographs, video clips and Spreadsheet need to saved on a DVD or Memory stick then brought to a central location where they will be filed/up loaded to the Show program according to the sizes and show classifications established for this competition.

The ZNA Judge and Trainee Judge based in EC, will judge these koi (from the photographs and Video clips). The Judges’ decision is final.

Prize winners

- Grand Champion
- Reserve Grand Champion.

- Best Go Sanke for each Size
- Best Non Go Sanke for each Size
Note: the above will take the place of all the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places
- Supreme Champion (size 1 to 9) will be selected from the above Go Sanke and Non Go Sanke.
- Baby Champion(Sizes 1 and 2)
- Junior Champion(Sizes 3, 4 and 5)
- Mature Champion(Sizes 6 and 7)
- Superior Champion(Sizes 8 and 9)

- Jumbo A (from Gosanke and Shiro Utsuri)
- Jumbo B (from all varieties other than Gosanke and Shiro Utsuri) will be selected
- Best overall Non Gosanke. (from all varieties other than Gosanke and Shiro Utsuri)

THE RULES

1. Only paid up members of the SAKKS Eastern Cape Chapter may enter this competition.
2. Anyone who tries to improve the quality of the koi by enhancing the quality of the photo / video or who records the incorrect size of the koi will be disqualified from the show. We recommend that all koi are photographed in a blue bowl.
3. Photos and/or Videos must not be older than two months. The koi must in the entrants pond.
4. An entrant may not enter more than 2 koi in the same size and show class.

All Completed Entries must be dropped off at Peter Stockenstrom's House, 25 Smart Road Nahoon, no later than 18h00 on Monday 6th July 2020. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCPETED.

Judging of the entries will be arranged amongst the judges during July 2020 and results will be announced via email once judging has been completed. Please write your email address on the envelope containing your photographs etc. so that you receive these results. No Trophies will be presented however a Virtual Certificate will be presented to the award winning entrants.
