



The KwaZulu Natal Chapter Koi Competition 2020

With our KwaZulu Natal Koi Show 2020 which was scheduled for 1-2 August 2020 having been cancelled the Chapter is organising a “virtual” show in its place. This is in essence a show where members can take a photograph of each koi they wish to enter on the show, measure it, put their name, koi size in cm’s, and variety on the back of the photograph and drop off their photographs at various drop off points in KwaZulu Natal. These photographs will then be brought to a central place where they will be filed according to the sizes and show classifications established for this competition. The ZNA Judges based in KZN, along with the KZN based trainees, will judge these koi (as in the photographs) and first select a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Thereafter they will award the places (1st, 2nd and 3rd) in each Size and Show Class. Nominations for Supreme Champions for each Size will be made and from these a Supreme Champion for each size will be selected. Finally a Baby Champion, Junior Champion, Mature Champion, Superior Champion, Jumbo A and Jumbo B will be selected as well as the Best Non Gosanke overall. So just like at our normal show – but based upon the photographs submitted.

KAWARIMOYO (including **Karasu-goi**: Hajiro, HageShiro, YotsuJiro, Matsukawabake/ Ginga, Ayawakabe, Beni / Kumonryu, SumiNagashi, Kikokuryu, Beni Kikokuryu AND **Kage Utsuri**: Shiro Kage Utsuri, Hi Kage Utsuri, Ki Kage Utsuri, Kage Showa AND **Kanoko**: Kanoko Kohaku, Kanoko Sanke, Kanoko Showa, Kanoko Asagi, etc AND **Ochiba**: Ochiba Shigure, Koyo, Kogane Ochiba-Shigure AND **Shusui Hybrids**: Sanke - Shusui, Showa - Shusui, Goshiki – Shusui AND other **Non-metallic** or Metallic two or more coloured patterned koi that do not fit into any other show classification AND **Doitsu** of these.

Size 6	60 Bu	52 cm to under 60 cm
Size 7	67 Bu	60 cm to under 67 cm
Size 8	75 Bu	67 cm to under 75 cm
Size 9	Over 75 Bu	75 cm and over

So as you will see from the above we are following exactly what we normally have for our shows, save for the awards for Best Potential Sizes 1-5.

THE RULES

1. Only paid up members of the SAKKS KwaZulu Natal Chapter may enter this competition.
2. Members must submit a clear, high quality photograph, which must not have been enhanced using any form of photo editing other than cropping which has been taken not more than two months prior to submission. Each photograph must be normal Jumbo print size (this is approximately 4x 6 inches or 102 X 152 mm) either gloss or matt finish on proper photo print paper – not normal everyday paper please. We recommend that all koi are photographed in a blue bowl.
3. An entrant may not enter more than 3 koi in the same size and show class.
4. The name of each member must be clearly printed on the back of each photograph, and below that clearly write the exact size of that koi in cm as measured at the time the photo is taken. Then below that size write the Show Class that koi is entered in. (This will be checked by the judges and re-benched as they may determine when viewing the photograph).
5. Once you have all the photographs ready as required above, place them in an envelope marked “ KWAZULU NATAL CHAPTER KOI COMPETITION, and deliver the envelope to one of the following drop off points but please call before dropping off so as to ensure someone is at the address:
